Summary

- °Campaign Finance Entity "Friends Of Peter Franchot" (FPF)
 - Had Unreported Transactions In All 4 Comptroller Campaigns
 Violating COMAR
 - Has Overcontributions From Individuals & PACs
 Violating Maryland Annotated Code
 - °Several Claimed Donor Entities Do Not Legally Exist As Claimed
- °Yet FPF Was Still Certified So That He Could Be Sworn In

Missing Transactions - Overview

Election	Transactions Missing	Minimum Missing
2006	Income	\$6,208.26
2010	Expenses	\$94,213.76
2014	Income	\$6,958.26
2018	Income (Carryforward)	\$6,958.26

• Missing Income Could Be Over \$6.2k + \$94k + \$6.9k = **\$107,380.28**

° Could Missing Income Be: Money Laundering Or Over Contributions?

° Could Missing Expenses Be: Bribes Or Other Prohibited Expenditures?

Missing Transactions - COMAR Review

° 33.13.08.06 – Failure to File

- Includes income or expenses missing or incorrect
- ° The Failure to File MUST be rectified
- ° The late filing penalty MUST be paid (or show cause)
- ° 33.18.01.02 Failure to Report
 - Expenditures: \$50 300 the first time, then \$250- \$500, then \$500 for 3rd and future times
 - Contributions: \$50 300 the first time, then \$250- \$500, then \$500 for 3rd and future times
 - ° KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY WITHOLDING \$500 each time
- ° 33.18.01.02 Failure to maintain account books and records
 - Expenditures / Contributions: \$100 each first time, then \$250, and \$500 for 3rd & future times
- ° There is no time limit or statue of limitations in COMAR to these violations

Contribution Limits - Code Summary

- 4 Year Cycle Limit : \$6,000 Per Person & \$6,000 Per PAC
 2015 2018
 - See Maryland Annotated Code Election Law § 13-226(b) (2017) For Person Limits
- °4 Year Cycle Limit: \$4,000 Per Person & \$6,000 Per PAC
 - » 2011 2014 » 2007 2010 » 2003 2006
 - ° MD Annotated Code Election Law § 13-226(b) (2014 2005) For Persons
 - ° MD Annotated Code Election Law § 13-227(c) (2017 2005) For Finance Entities

At Least \$200,000 in Over Contributions

Over Contributions - Examples

° Examples General To Protect Entities (Errors May Be FPF Issues)

- ° More Exist Needs More Investigation
- ° Some Details Sent To State Prosecutor & Campaign Finance Director

Questionable Donors - Summary

Several Claimed Contributors Have Questionable Existence
 Campaign Finance Entities – PACs, Candidate Committees, Etc.
 Business Entities – LLCs & Corporations

To Protect Entities Found (Errors Could Be FPF Issues)
General Descriptions Discussed - Actual Names Not Listed Here
I Will Send To The State Prosecutor & Campaign Finance Director
Tested Only Some - May Be More

At Least \$268,000

Questionable Donors - Committees

° Contributor Type: <u>Candidate</u> Committee

- ° Example Claimed Candidate Committee Was Named An Alliance (Not A Candidate)
- ° The Alliance Name Was Not Registered As Any Type Of Committee
- ° Contributor Type: Unregistered Out-of-state Non-federal Committee
 - ° Only Allowed If Committee Is Properly Registered In Its Own State
 - ° The Contributor Committee Not Registered In State Claimed

° Contributor Type: <u>PAC</u> Committee

- ° Various Labor Organizations Not Registered And Active At Time Of Donations
- ° Other Labor Organizations and Contributors Were Listed And Registered Then
- ° Contributor Type: <u>Registered</u> Out-of-state Non-federal Committee
 - ° The Biggest Category Of Contributors Not Registered
 - ° Some Were Registered Later, Before (But Ended Before Donation Claimed), or Never

Questionable Donors - Businesses

° Several Claimed Donor Businesses (LLC, INC, Co)

- Claimed Contribution Type: Check
- ° Lists Specific State's Physical Addresses
- ° Not Registered At The State Dept Of Assessments & Taxation (Not A Legal Entity)
- <u>Legal Check Name & Address Should Be Where Business Is Legal</u>
 <u>Is This Donor Name And/Or Contribution Type Incorrect?</u>
- These Behaviors Can Occur In
 - Money Laundering & Prohibited Contributions
 - ° More Over Contributions From Special Interests

Concluding Remarks - Requests

° FPF Should Be De-Certified

- ° FPF Should Be Required To Return Prohibited & Over Contributions
- Franchot Should Not Be Sworn In Until Failures To File Rectified (Law)
 Missing Transactions & Listing Wrong Donors Are Failures To File
- ° Knowing And Willful Failures Should Be Investigated
- ° If FPF Can Not Rectify These Issues In 30 Days
 - ° I, The 2nd Place Winner, Should Be The Official Winner
 - ° I Am The Only Campaign Finance Law Abiding Candidate
 - ° Law Should Be Upheld
